

Antibiotic Restriction Information

(For ID Approval, Page #10073)

1. Commonly used **unrestricted** antibiotics include:

Vancomycin IV	Timentin	Cefepime	Fluconazole IV and PO
Ciprofloxacin PO and IV	Ceftriaxone (1g only)	Cefoxitin	

2. Recently changed: **Ceftriaxone 2g** and **Moxifloxacin IV/PO** are under **partial restriction** and **Cefepime & Fluconazole** are **unrestricted**

3. **ID approval for use of restricted drugs** must be obtained between 8am to 10pm by paging **#10073**. Only PARTIALLY restricted drugs will be dispensed by pharmacy during the hours of 10pm and 8am and then the next day approval must be obtained. Overnight use of partially restricted antibiotics is being tracked carefully. ID-on-call is active 24/7 for all emergency inquiries at #10073.
